-In November of 2006, USFS Austin/Tonopah Ranger District proposed new AML's for 7 of it's WHT's, all which interact with BLM HMA's. Proposal is currently pending.

-The 2007 National Gather Schedule reports gathering and removing 169 wild horses in January 2007.

-Jan. 2007 Stone Cabin Complex EA (NV065-EA07-028) states that horses from the Nellis Wild Horse Range travel in Monitor too.
