Also, please make sure that you include me in the Nevada Wild Horse Range Herd Management Area Plan Susie Stokke has assured me is due out very soon for public review as well as the resetting the Appropriate Management Levels for the Johnnie, Red Rock and Wheeler Pass HMAs.

Actions:

Planning range developments or range improvements (i.e. fencing), reports which evaluate monitoring data (i.e., allotment evaluations), adjustments to wild horse appropriate management levels, all management actions including wild horse and burro removals, wild horse and burro management plans, wildlife proposals including species introductions, habitat improvements or enhancements, biological opinions, changes to HMA boundaries or designations, Resource Management Plans, Land Use Plans and designated Wilderness Areas or Wilderness Study Areas.

Other proposals that affect the listed HA, HMAs and allotments including:

OHV Management Plans, Mining, Geothermal, Water Rights & Transfers, new public lands designations and proposals and any other management plan, proposal or action that would affect the areas listed of interest that are currently unforeseen.
