In 1980, Stone Cabin HMA alone had an estimated wild horse population of 2,300.

Additional Facts on Area:

Gather area is adjacent to many HMAs (Known as Fish Creek Complex) that were gathered in Summer 2005 and Winter 2006 which removed 1,179 total horses. Horse distribution patterns have been noted as disrupted and many horses are now residing in areas previously unoccupied. Proposal will remove 521 more: 1,700 in 1 ½ years.

Between both Complexes (Fish Creek and Stone Cabin)

540 Horses will remain on 2,027,945 acres.
